# HELEN KELLER

On June 27, 1880, Helen Keller was born in Tuscumbia, Alabama. After a childhood illness, she lost the ability to see and hear.



In 1887, Anne Sullivan came to teach Helen so that she could communicate. Eventually, Helen learned sign language, braille, and how to speak.

In 1904 she graduated from Radcliffe College and became the first blind and deaf graduate with a Liberal Arts degree.
