Participants will get to tour the Constitutions, travel to Constitution Village, Burritt on the Mountain, and listen to many experts ranging from early Alabama history, Reconstruction, and the future of Alabama and Huntsville moving forward. Teachers will leave with activities, resources, and materials to add to their educational toolbox and encouraged to celebrate Alabama's history both inside and outside of the classroom.
